- 3. Review your day recall specific moments and your feelings at the time.
- 4. Reflect on what you did, said, or thought in those instances. Were you drawing closer to God, or further away?
- 5. Look toward tomorrow think of how you might collaborate more effectively with God's plan. Be specific, and conclude with the "Our Father."

May this Fall be a time of recognizing God's many sprinkles of love.

Pastor Inger will lead the service. The 8:00 am service will remain the same.
- Elder Sandy Gallagher [Outreach Ministry Team] reminded everyone of the fund raiser for Hope's Legacy Sept. 21<sup>st</sup> from 2-5. Posters have been put up in many local spots as well as advertising. There will be a silent auction for Connie Underwood's exquisite artwork and for two gift certificates from Iron and Ale.
- Elder Sally Bryant [Personnel] has written a new policy for hiring personnel.
- Elder Jeri Engebretson [Christian Education Ministry Team] reported that children's programs have begun and classes have been divided into four groups: toddlers & preschool, 1st & 2nd grades, 3rd and & 4th grades, and 5th grade & middle school. Volunteers are still needed. On Wednesdays, 10/2, 10,16, and 10/23 from 11:30 to 12:30, Brent Kitching will facilitate a class entitled "Mindfulness: Cultivation Inner Peace in a Turbulent World." All are welcome. The Adult Sunday School Class will begin a study of "Mere Christianity" on Sunday mornings at 9:00 beginning 10/13/24. All are welcome.
- Elder Kathy Kristiansen [Liaison Grounds] reported that Roberto's Landscaping, LLC has completed the weeding and mulching around the entrances to the church.
- Elder Joe Steele [Cemetery Ministry Team] reported that trees shielding the neighboring property will soon be planted.
